- ◆ *To distribute 1.2 million pounds of food and grocery items every month*
- ◆ *To support over half of San Diego's food kitchens and pantry programs that have no paid staff and rely entirely on volunteers*

Volunteer Opportunities

Feeding America Volunteer programs making a big impact on families in San Diego:

- ◆ **Farm2Kids:** 2000 bags of fresh produce are provided to school age children each week in kid-friendly bags.
- ◆ **Backpack:** 2,000 bags of staples and produce for children on weekends when they cannot receive free lunch at school.
- ◆ **Food Sorting:** sorting, organizing and repacking bulk food into family-sized portions for nearly a million meals each year.
- ◆ **Office Help:** assist in filling, data entry and other clerical duties.
