## Annual Lecture Series for 2011: A Historical Perspective On U.S. Cultural Wars

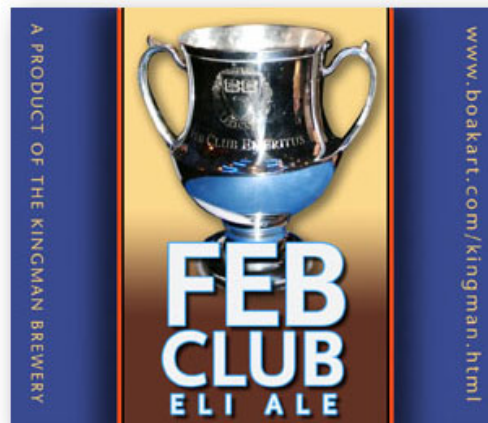

In this sweeping history, Mr. Arenson reveals a city at the heart of the cultural civil war that ensued.
