Speaker: Dr. Jeffrey Mankoff, Associate Director of International Studies at Yale and Adjunct Fellow for Russia Studies at the Council on Foreign Relations. Previously the John N. Olin National Security Fellow at Harvard and a fellow at Moscow State University. After receiving his MA from Yale in Political Science, he received his Ph.D. from Yale in 2006.

Dr. Mankoff is an acknowledged expert on Russian foreign policy, continuity and change in the post-Soviet era, U.S.-Russian relations, the role of political parties, the Balkan crisis and the diplomacy of Tsarist Russia.
